- **Increased funding for visiting and reunification programs that help keep families connected when a mother is in prison.**
- **Medicaid coverage for women transitioning from prison and jail back to their communities.**
- **Better health services for women in prison and more oversight of the HIV and Hepatitis C care provided in state correctional facilities by the NYS Department of Health.**
- **Merit time and early release from prison for domestic violence survivors incarcerated for committing crimes as a result of abuse.**
- **Further reform of the Rockefeller Drug Laws & increased funding for drug treatment & alternatives to incarceration for women.**

On March 6, join the Coalition to call on New York's elected officials to stop spending millions of dollars on prison - an inhumane & ineffective response to the social ills that drive crime - & to expand community-based, gender-specific alternative programs that save money & rebuild lives.

Advocate for policies that protect the rights of incarcerated women & for an increase in services that enable women to make a healthy, safe & productive return to their families & communities after prison.
